ORDER AMENDING RENEWED CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD

On June 30, 2011, the Public Service Board issued a final order renewing the Certificate of Public Good ("CPG") held by Southern Vermont Cable Company ("Southern Vermont") to provide cable television service to eleven towns in Vermont. The Order and CPG were based upon a memorandum of understanding ("MOU") between the parties: Southern Vermont; the Vermont Department of Public Service ("Department"); and Brattleboro Community Television, the local access management organization.

It now appears that the MOU did not accurately reflect the agreement of the parties. By letter filed on October 21, 2011, the Department has moved, pursuant to V.R.C.P. 60(b), for relief from the Order issued on June 30. The relief requested is the insertion of two filing requirements that Southern Vermont had agreed to, but that were omitted from the proposed CPG submitted with the MOU. The Department represents that both of the other parties support its motion to amend.

The requested changes are small and reasonable¹ and, more importantly, reflect the actual agreement of the parties. Therefore, an amended Certificate of Public Good shall be issued to Southern Vermont Cable Company to incorporate the afore-mentioned filing requirements.

SO ORDERED.

1. One adds to condition 3 of the CPG that Southern Vermont must file its public access plan with the Board and the Department with its next annual report pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 22. The other adds to condition 8(a) the requirement that, if Southern Vermont amends its access plan, it must file the amendment with its next annual report.
